COLLECTIVE WORSHIP POLICY

The Governing Body of Callington Community College have thoroughly investigated the implementation of a daily act of collective worship. The context of this investigation is within the guidance provided by the College mission, which is basically centred on valuing each individual, embedding respect and raising levels of self-esteem in order to develop the aspirations in each person to achieve their own personal best and to become generative citizens.

In relation to this the college invests heavily in individual growth and, in particular, individual tutoring. This has led to a very different tutor system where tutor groups do not all meet daily. This coupled with the fact that the College does not have the facilities to collect together more than one year group, means that the requirement for a daily act of collective worship is not possible to be satisfied.

Regardless of this situation, the Governors are keen to promote spiritual, moral and cultural awareness through collective action. In order to do this the following are in operation:

- All year groups have a weekly assembly which incorporates the collective act of worship.
- The start to the first lesson each day has a 'five minute reflection for the day ahead time'. This involves brain gym and a thought for the day.
- Spiritual, moral and cultural awareness is fully embodied in the eight conditions for raising student aspirations, which are being embedded into every aspect of the college.

This policy will be re-viewed annually.
