COLLEGE UNIFORM – WEAR IT WELL!

(These revised guidelines to apply from September 2010)

At Callington Community College our aim is to keep the uniform requirements as simple as possible whilst maintaining high standards in terms of appearance and dress.

The Health and Safety of students is always upper most in our minds and many of the regulations outlined here are based on safeguarding our students.

The uniform guidance outlined below appears detailed. The aim is to minimise confusion and remove the possibility of any potential conflict between staff and students and students and parents. Such confusion and conflict can stand in the way of students' learning and learning is our focus.

TROUSERS	Plain, black material	Not denim or corduroy material No cargo, jeans or jean style trousers, with rivets, large stitching They should not be so long that they drag on the ground *Shorts, Cropped Trousers, Leggings/Jeggings are not acceptable
SKIRTS	Plain, black material Such a length that they are appropriate for college activities-that is between MID-CALF and KNEE LENGTH	Not denim or corduroy material. No culottes, pleated or split skirts
BELTS	Plain, black	No fashion belts, and not attached to trousers unless plain black
SWEATSHIRTS	Plain navy blue college sweatshirt or hoodie with college logo For diploma students this will be a diploma sweatshirt, or plain black sweatshirt worn only on principal learning days	*No other sweatshirts or hoodies
POLO SHIRTS	Plain navy blue polo-shirt with college logo - long or short sleeved or college service polo shirt with college logo For diploma students this will be a black polo shirt with diploma logo	Not college royal blue PE polo shirts. *No other polo shirts are acceptable. T-Shirts underneath polo shirts are also not acceptable
SOCKS / TIGHTS	Black socks Plain black / natural tights	No other coloured socks or tights

SHOES	<p>Plain, black shoes or plain, completely black, trainers</p> <p>Suitable for college activities, comfortable and giving reasonable support</p> <p>Laces must also be plain black</p>	<p>No other colour than black</p> <p>No fashion shoes, such as skater shoes (e.g. Vans)</p> <p>No boots, footwear with heels or lacking heel support (e.g. flip flops)</p> <p>No footwear with any logo on that is not black</p> <p>*Trainers other than black are only permitted with a medical note</p> <p>*Students who are unable to wear the correct college footwear will be provided with a pair of plain black plimsolls</p>
TOP COATS	<p>Acceptable for college use and should only be worn outside or between lessons</p> <p>Optional plain navy blue fleece with college logo</p>	<p>Not denim, no hoodies other than those bearing the college logo</p> <p>No cardigans or tracksuit tops</p> <p>Not displaying any inappropriate logos</p>
JEWELLERY	<p>Single plain ring</p> <p>Discrete single small studs or one pair of small earrings</p>	<p>Earrings known as stretchers are not allowed</p> <p>Nose studs and other piercings are not allowed</p> <p>No necklaces, bracelets unless of a medical nature</p> <p>No charity bands</p>
HAIR		<p>No extremes of hair fashion /colour (discretion of the Headteacher)</p>
MAKE-UP	<p>In Years 9 to13 students may wear discrete make-up</p> <p>Colourless nail varnish only may be worn</p>	<p>No make up to be worn in Years 7 and 8</p> <p>No brightly coloured nail varnish</p> <p>No false nails or nail extensions of any kind are allowed as they represent a health and safety risk</p> <p>*Students will be asked to remove make-up and nail varnish if inappropriate</p>
HATS /SCARVES	<p>These should be appropriate</p> <p>Only worn outside in cold or wet weather</p>	<p>These should not be worn inside</p> <p>No bandanas or head scarves</p>
